Wineries Across Mendoza's Top Wine Regions

Luján de Cuyo

In **Luján de Cuyo**, the birthplace of Argentina's Malbec, you'll find legendary producers like *Catena Zapata*, *Susana Balbo*, *Lagarde*, *Pulenta Estate*, *Kaiken*, *Foster Lorca* and *Benegas*. These bodegas combine historic cellars with cutting-edge tasting experiences and gourmet dining.

Maipú

In **Maipú**, explore the historical roots of Argentine winemaking. Highlights include Trapiche, Santa Julia, El Enemigo, Tempus Alba, and Carinae, where heritage meets innovation in a more rural setting just minutes from Mendoza city.

Uco Valley

In **Uco Valley**, discover altitude and innovation at wineries such as Zuccardi, Andeluna, Domaine Bousquet, Masi Tupungato, Finca Adelma, and Salentein. This area is known for its modern architecture, sustainable practices, and elegant wines framed by stunning Andean scenery.

Mendoza City and Surrounding Towns

Beyond the vineyards, Mendoza offers urban and semi-rural spaces where you can enjoy culture, food, and local charm.

- **Mendoza City** is the provincial capital and serves as a starting point for most visitors. Use the map to locate major plazas, museums, pedestrian areas, and local markets.
- Just outside the city, towns like **Chacras de Coria** and **Vistalba** provide a relaxed, upscale atmosphere with boutique lodgings, wine bars, and farm-to-table restaurants.
- **Maipú's rural roads** are also home to olive groves, artisan shops, and food experiences you can pair with half-day winery visits.

These locations are ideal for slow mornings, cultural stops, or overnight stays with quick access to nearby wine regions.



Nature, Scenic Routes and Protected Areas

The map includes several natural landmarks and breathtaking drives that you may want to incorporate into your itinerary:

- **Aconcagua Provincial Park**, home to the highest mountain in the Americas, offers short hikes, lookouts, and access to areas like *Laguna de Horcones* and *Confluencia*.

- **Puente del Inca**, a unique geological formation with a historic railway stop, and the **Christ the Redeemer monument** on the Chilean border are highlighted as must-see stops in the high Andes.
- **Potreros** and **Cacheuta**, just an hour from Mendoza City, are noted for their natural beauty, lakeside views, and thermal baths — perfect for a scenic break or adventure activities.
- Further south, **San Rafael** and the **Cañón del Atuel** offer impressive landscapes, reservoirs, and water sports. The map also marks **Malargüe** and **Las Leñas**, two key locations for snow experiences during winter.
- In the northern desert, you'll find **Altos Limpios in Lavalle**, a surreal area of dunes and silence that's ideal for slow travel and local heritage encounters.



Outdoor Activities, Culinary Spots and Lodging Options

Mendoza isn't just wine — it's also a playground for nature lovers, foodies, and travelers seeking comfort. The map includes:

- **Whitewater rafting areas** on the Mendoza River
- **Horseback riding circuits** in Uco Valley and Manzano Histórico
- **Trekking and hiking routes** in the Andes and high mountain villages

- **Winter sports centers**, such as Las Leñas and Vallecitos

Roads Worth Driving

This map also highlights Mendoza's most picturesque and strategic routes:

- **Route 89**, also known as *Camino de los Cerrillos*, is a panoramic road connecting Tupungato and Tunuyán. It's especially photogenic in autumn and ideal for slow drives through the vineyards.
- **Route 40**, Argentina's most iconic north-south highway, links all three wine regions and serves as a backbone for road trips across Mendoza.
- **Route 7** takes you west to the Andes, passing Potrerillos, Cacheuta, Uspallata and all the way to Aconcagua Park and the Chilean border.

Understanding the layout of these routes helps travelers plan realistic drive times and scenic detours.

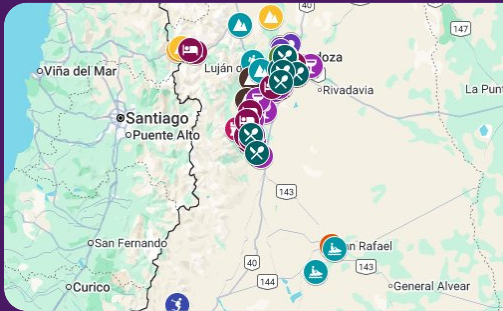
